by Medicare, to accept the Medicare payment amount for the service, and not to bill you for more than the Medicare deductible and coinsurance.)

There's no yearly limit on what you pay out-of-pocket under Original Medicare.

If you're in a Medicare Advantage plan (like an HMO or PPO) or have other insurance, your costs may be different. Contact your plan or benefits administrator directly to find out about the costs.

Under Part B, Medicare pays for many preventive services that can detect health problems early when they're easier to treat. You pay nothing for most covered preventive services if you get the services from a doctor or other qualified provider who accepts assignment.

However, for some preventive services, you may have to pay a deductible, coinsurance, or both.

Medicare doesn't cover everything, of course. If you need certain services that aren't covered under Part A or Part B, you'll have to pay for them yourself unless you have other insurance (including Medicaid) to cover the costs or you're in a Medicare Advantage plan that covers these services.

Some of the services and goods that Medicare Parts A and B don't cover include most dental care, eye exams related to prescribing glasses, dentures, cosmetic surgery, massage therapy, routine physical exams, long-term care, concierge care (also called concierge medicine, retainer-based medicine, and boutique medicine) and hearing aids and exams for fitting them.

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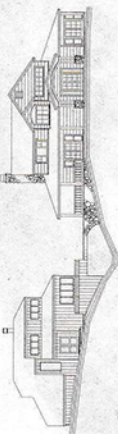
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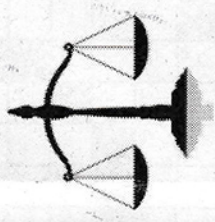
